Principal's Message October 16, 2020

This Friday night, Hagerty High School will host its first home varsity football game. Capacity is limited and tickets can be purchased on Gofan.co. If you have previously used the APP, remember to refresh by pulling down on the screen to populate new links since your last visit. Please remember that spectators are expected to maintain social distancing when possible and should be wearing a face covering at all times. I know that this is an outdoor event, but please remember that you are expected to wear a face covering while in the stands. We welcome you to sit as a family unit, but please social distance your group from other groups where appropriate in the stands. There will be no standing along the railings of the bleachers or the fence line near the track as all spectators will utilize the available seating in the stands. Finally, children will not be allowed to play anywhere on campus and must remain in the stands with their parents.

I really need your help in following these protocols. I understand that many of you do not agree with the face covering policy, and I am not here to engage in that debate. However, Seminole County Public Schools, in conjunction with the Florida Department of Health in Seminole County, has approved these protocols in order to allow us to have fans in the stands. I am tired of having to engage in heated discussion with adults who do not want to comply. I would receive numerous e-mails and phone calls if I was observed not wearing a mask on the sidelines. To me, this is a small price to pay to have the opportunity to watch our students compete and allow them to have some normal high school experience back. I am willing to wear one for them!

Finally, we are working on expanding our stadium capacity to 50% for future games, but this will be dependent upon our community's ability to comply with our current protocols. I look forward to working with you in our quest to expand capacity and support our programs as the year progresses. Our next home football game is versus Oviedo at the end of the month. As our school motto says, "Working together to create a tradition of excellence," all of us can work together to create an atmosphere our teams deserve at our venues.
