Advanced Placement Test Performance

2021-2022 Data



Hagerty High School administered 1657 Advanced Placement exams in 31 courses (**at no cost** to students). The most popular AP courses are World History, US History, Computer Science Principles, US Government and Politics, and English Language and Composition.

HHS had an average **pass rate of 73%** on AP exams. For comparison, the Florida pass rate was 51%, and the national pass rate was 57%.

SAT Scores

All juniors and seniors at HHS get an opportunity to take the SAT **at no cost**.

The average Hagerty High School SAT score is **1093** out of 1600, higher than the Florida average of 983.

HHS students in 9-11th grade have an opportunity to take the PSAT **at no cost**.

HHS 10th graders had an average PSAT score of **1017** out of 1520, higher than the Florida average of 890.

73% of HHS students take some form of acceleration (college-level classes or industry certifications).

HHS also offers **5 industry certifications**. Some of the most popular ones are Certified Food Safety Manager and Certified Food Protection Manager (ServSafe®). In total, students earned **550 industry certifications**.

- HHS has a total enrollment of 2,449 students across grades 9-12.
- Our Program of Emphasis is Modeling, Simulation and Analysis, Science Research, Robotics and Computer Programming.
- In the 2021-2022 school year, 35% of HHS graduates qualified for Bright Futures scholarships.
- We offer 60 different clubs, including many Honor Societies, Robotics Team, Academic Teams, and Modeling and Simulation.
- HHS offers many courses catering to the arts, including award winning theater, band, chorus, dance, art, newspaper and yearbook.
- The athletics program consists of 50 different teams, earning state championships in cheer, basketball, softball, and volleyball.
- HHS offers 31 Advanced Placement (AP) courses with 1698 exams administered in the 2020-2021 school year with a 72% pass rate.
